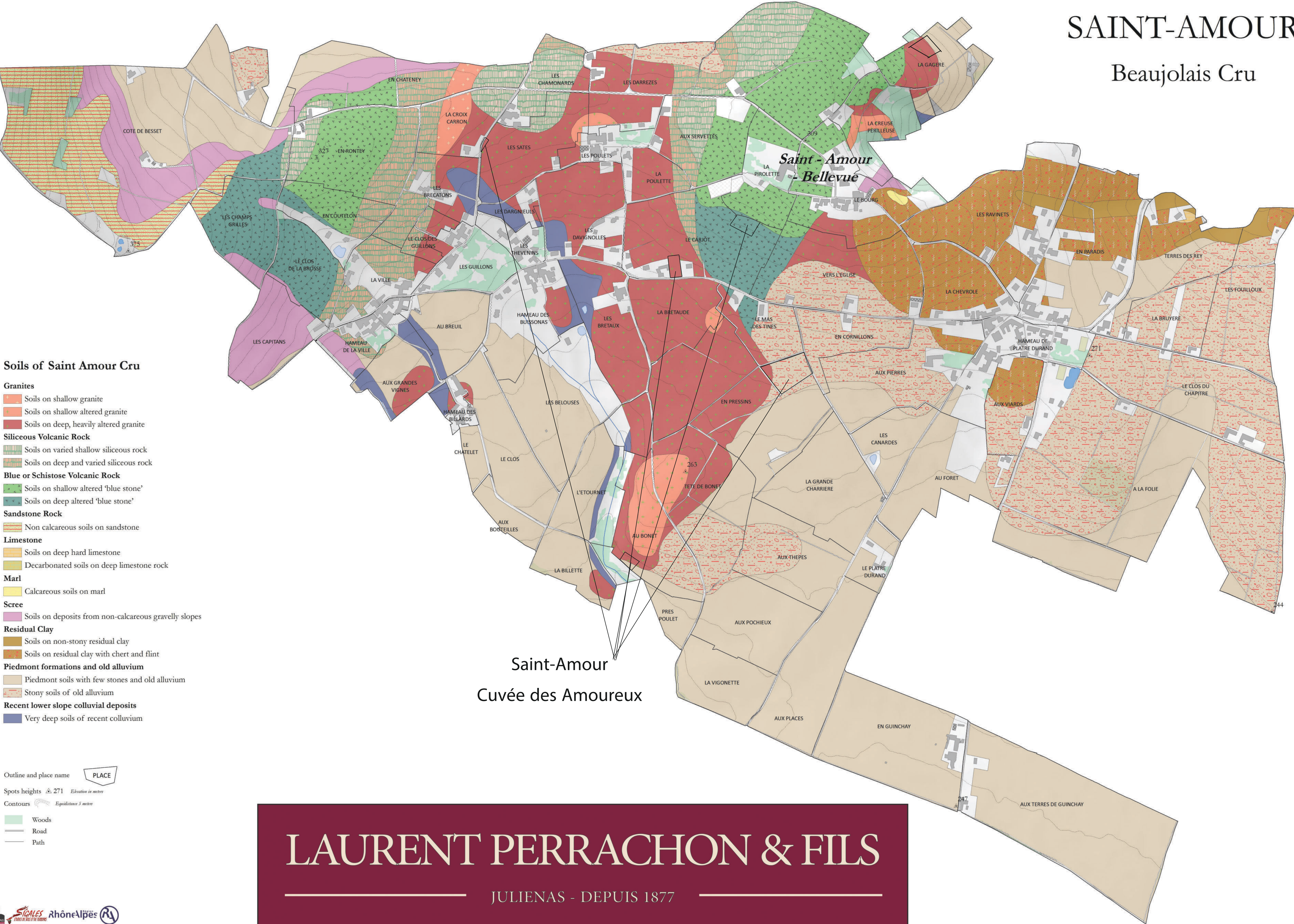

- Granites**
- Soils on shallow granite

- Soils on non-stony residual clay
 - Soils on residual clay with chert and flint
- Piedmont formations and old alluvium**
- Piedmont soils with few stones and old alluvium
 - Stony soils of old alluvium
- Recent lower slope colluvial deposits**
- Very deep soils of recent colluvium
